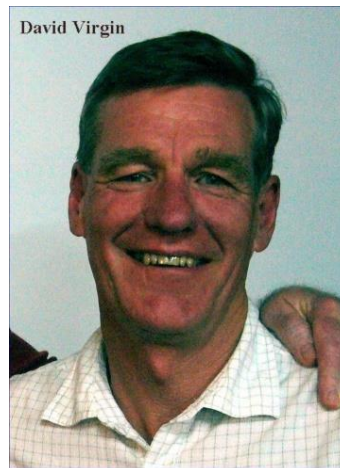

Southern Volunteering Fleurieu is a Federal Funded volunteer resource centre with an office in Victor Harbor and Christies Beach offering volunteering brokerage services and training to individuals living on the Fleurieu Peninsula and Kangaroo Island. Training and support is also offered to volunteer managers and coordinators. Southern Volunteering is managed by 5 staff members and a host of volunteers who interview potential volunteers and match them with organisations on a skills basis.

Mayo has the highest rate of volunteers in Australia.

The benefits of volunteering are numerous – not just about giving to your community but you can get a lot back in return from being involved in such an event - both personally and professionally.

100 volunteers participate in the Community Visitor Scheme which provides volunteers who visit isolated people.
