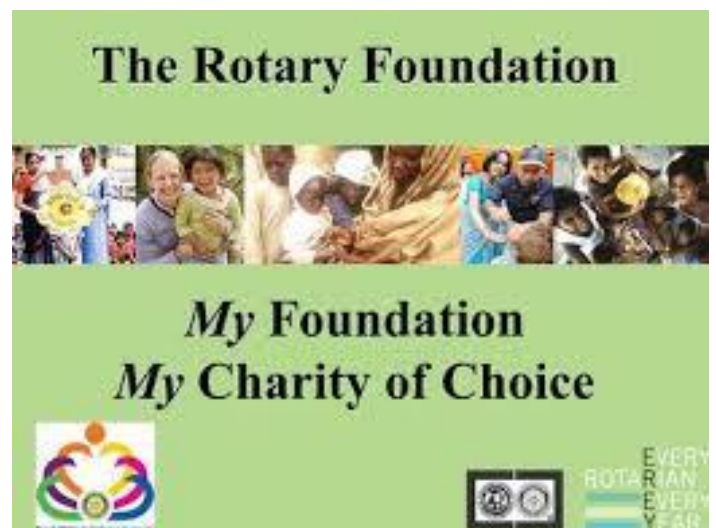
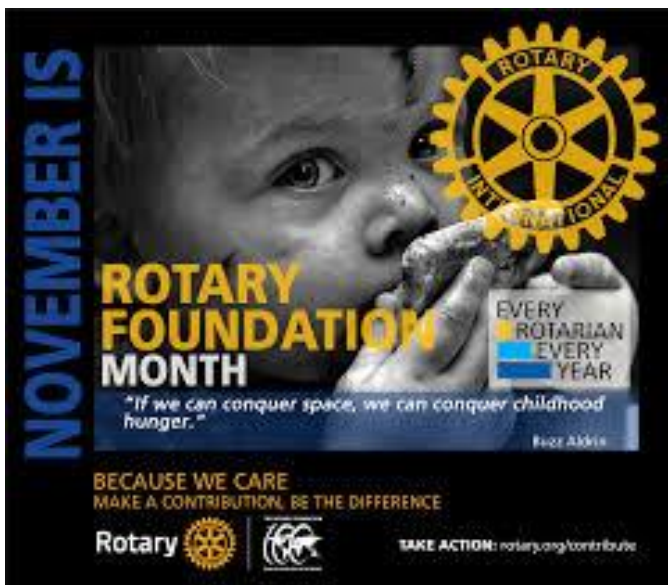

## **Guest Speaker: Brenton Abbott on The Rotary Foundation**

The Rotary Foundation is one of the most worthy projects of Rotary which all clubs should participate. It is our Foundation - one of the largest in the world, which uses contributions donated by clubs, individual Rotarians and the general public to fund major humanitarian and educational projects throughout the world. Many of the projects are carried out in partnership. Large projects are often with governments and other not for profit organisations, smaller projects are arranged between clubs in different countries. Individuals can donate \$100 a year to the Centurion fund. Such Rotarians will be recognised as Centurions with a certificate and a lapel badge. All such donations are eligible for a tax credit in Australia.

Clubs can apply to use the funds for District Simplified Grants. They can also apply for educational programs such as Group Study Exchange, Ambassadorial Scholars and Peace Scholars.
