Topic: Fleurieu Community Foundation.

The FCF is the Fleurieu Peninsulas' local philanthropic organisation to invest in the future of our local community.

Brad summarised the work of the Foundation which was formed in 2010. In the first year, \$13,000 was dispersed in grants, in 2020/21; \$160,000 will be dispersed from the FCF.

The Foundation supports the communities of the Alexandrina, Victor Harbor and Yankalilla Council areas with a total population of 45,000. Twelve programs are managed including homelessness services with Junction Australia and Southern Christian Community Care.

Recently the Early Intervention Program has been funded by the FCF and the Wyatt Trust.

Funds are raised through the Wally Bradley Annual Quiz Night – coming up on 4<sup>th</sup> June and Pip Robertson's Open Garden on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> May at Back Valley.

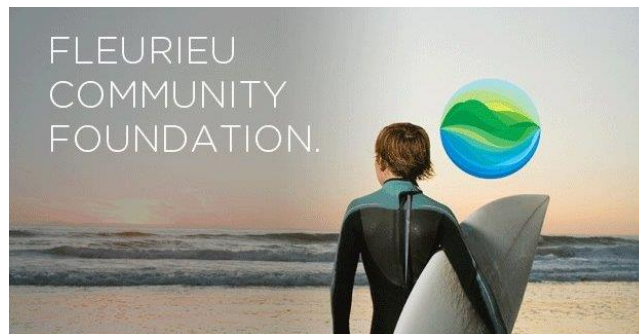
