On Thursday, April 21st in 1921, 37 prominent Melbourne citizens, including General Sir John Monash, gathered at Scott's Hotel, Collins Street, for the inaugural lunch meeting of the newly formed Rotary Club of Melbourne: the first Rotary Club in Australasia.

Three more clubs followed that same year in Sydney, Auckland and Wellington. Last month we celebrated 100 years of *Doing Good* across our regions and across the globe. 100 years of *Service Above Self*. 100 years of action and transforming lives and communities for the greater good.

From 37 members in April 1921 to nearly 33,000 members in 1306 clubs in 2021, we have surpassed many milestones along the way.
