Guest Speaker: Brenton Hudson, Principal, Port Elliot Primary School

Topic: Port Elliot Primary School

Port Elliot Primary School has 451 students in 18 classes with 61 staff. The focus is on educating the whole child with academics and wellbeing.

The school values:

Community: The emphasis is on caring for each other and the environment.

Confidence: Developed through self-esteem and a focus on wellbeing.

Respect: The language used and actions undertaken are expected to be respectful towards others and the environment.

Brenton described 2 areas (Zones) available to students:

- The zone for sensory learning offers students to be taught regulation strategies. This assists in building academic achievement, positive growth and social competence. Emotional regulation, sensory processing and executive functioning are addressed.
- The switch is a space for students with high energy. It incorporates the philosophies of the Zone and includes therapy dogs Eddie and Bailey.

Inside classroom learning is enhanced with many facilities in the surrounding communities.

Camps include Monarto Safari Park, Illawonga River Murray, Flinders Ranges, Canberra and the Murputja Anangu School (APY Lands).

Year 7, next year, will be offered at high schools.

Brenton is pleased with the school Naplan results and feedback from parents is very positive.
