PE Ken Carter advised members that the applications for Community Grants have been assessed. After all successful applicants have been officially notified there will be a list and outline of each project in the newsletter.

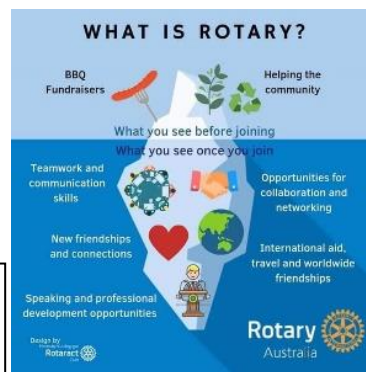
