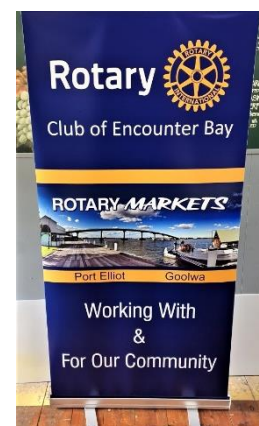

Granite Island Causeway Project

Darius recognised the Ngarrindjeri and Ramindjeri people and the land on which the Granite Island Causeway Project is being constructed and where we meet.

In his role as Delivery Manager for the Department of Transport, Dariusz is managing the Causeway Project and other infrastructure projects throughout South Australia; including the Darlington Project.

In 2019 the Causeway was in very much a dilapidated state. It had suffered the effects of white ants, marine borers and the weather etc. It had only 12% of the original material remaining. Operational restrictions were activated if, for example, the wind was >100km/hr.

A decision was made to construct a new causeway with a 100-year design life.

The new Causeway will:

- Include upgrades to the plaza area and Granite Island
- Have a 10-metre offset, with the tram on one side
- Have a 3-metre wide pathway
- Allow full access to emergency vehicles
- Have a Fox-gate (with a cunning design)

To build the structure there are 2 cranes; 1 for piling and the 2nd for pre-cast concrete decking – manufactured in South Australia; Bianco on Grand Junction Road. The pre-cast concrete has longevity and each decking weighs 45 tonne.

5 barges brought materials for the abutment works at the VH and Granite Island ends. Progress at this time is >80% piles and around 70% pre-cast decking completed.

Environmental Risks, value adding and mitigations include:

- Working with the Ngarrindjeri and Ramindjeri people
- Engaging expert groups and individuals to monitor impacts on whales, penguins, dolphins, seals etc. Marine spotters are included.
- The use of a piling gate. As the water is shallow – a casing surrounding the pile assists with lessening the under-water noise.

The future:

- When the project is complete the re-use of timbers will be considered:
 - Community groups, seating, art – will depend on how much is useable.
