The Birds of the Hindmarsh River Trail

Malcolm thanked the Rotary Club of Encounter Bay for the support he received to publish his book. He also thanked Gayl Males, South Coast Environment Centre.

Malcolm, since childhood has had an interest in nature, the environment and a passion for wildlife. This interest has culminated in his undertaking a double degree at the Flinders University.

What was named the Mount Lofty Ranges is now the Hills and Fleurieu Region of South Australia. On our doorstep are 80 species of birds. And, there are >375 plant and animal species. Each of the birds has a page with a photo (all taken by Malcolm), a general description and a map showing where it may be located. Within the 5 trails; Lagoon, Paperbark, Waggon, Wattle and McCracken there are a wide variety of habitats.

The book also has sections on;

- Potential threats to birdlife
- Attracting birds to your backyard
- Threatened Birds of the trail and, is available in Victor Harbor from the Book Shop, Urimbirra Wildlife Park and South Coast Environment Centre. In Goolwa the book is available at Art Works.

Written for enthusiasts and people who enjoy the outdoors the book is a brilliant record of the birds in our local area.

Malcolm advised members that there will be a Nature Festival on the 29th September, 2021. Information available from the South Coast Environment Centre.
