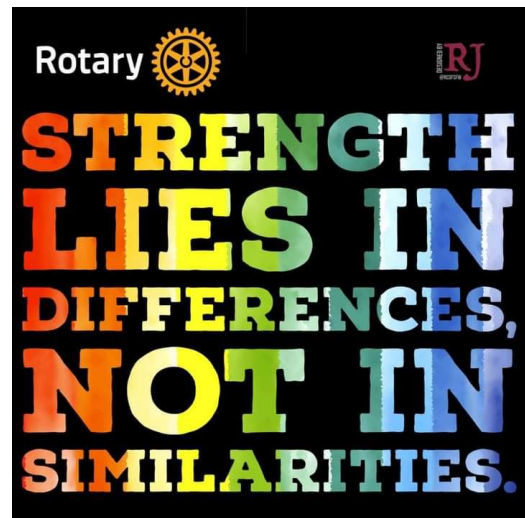

Building Runways in India....



Jodi is the Manager of Infrastructure with the City of Victor Harbor.

The journey to her position in Victor Harbor has been varied and interesting.

- Jodi's father was a Rotarian with the RC of Onkaparinga where he undertook many roles. As a child, Rotary experiences were family experiences. Just a few; Youth Exchange, BBQ's and GSE. And, pancakes for tea when her father went to Rotary meetings!
- In 1994, the RC of Barossa sponsored Jodi to attend a National Youth Science Forum. At the forum Jodi was selected to represent South Australia at a forum in Auckland, New Zealand.
- Civil Engineering studies have resulted in Jodi possessing qualifications:
 - Bachelor of Civil Engineering – University of Adelaide
 - Masters degree in Pavement Technology Concrete and Ashphalt – Monash and Latrobe Universities in Melbourne.
 - And, Jodi is a member of the Institute of Public Works Engineering Australia and the Institute of Engineers Australia.
- Civil Engineering is the design, construction and maintenance of the physical and naturally built environment.

Working for Larsen and Toubro

In 2009, Jodi had an opportunity, working as an engineer in India, to build runways to enable A380 aircraft to land in readiness for the 2010 Commonwealth Games.

The standards in Australia and India for building the runways were the same.

There were some differences working in India:

- Labour is less expensive than technology.
- There were 22,000 labourers on-site for Jodi's projects.
- Males tend to undertake administration work while women are engineers.
- Women tend to take their children to work – this is difficult in labour intensive work.

In 2013 there was another opportunity to work in India. And, to support women in their working and family lives.

Jodi's family is important – demonstrated by the photos of her young son in a safety vest (too big just yet) and "driving" a large machine. A promise of things to come.
