The history and practices whereby the private hospital is co-located with the public hospital were described in detail by Phil.

- The hospital is now part of the Barossa Hills Fleurieu Health Network along with 11 other hospitals and health services. There are 9 volunteer board members. The VH private hospital is the last hospital in South Australia to be co-located with a public hospital.
- Approximately 50 GP doctors in the Fleurieu refer patients and there are many visiting specialists who use the facilities.
- The costs of technology and diagnostic tools are growing. For example; 3 drills and a saw (reamer) can cost \$50,000.
- Technology is driving down the number of hospital stays with many procedures being replaced by same-day operations.
- Profits made by the hospital are used to purchase equipment; for example, each room now has cardio monitoring capabilities.
- Finances need to be closely monitored to ensure services and procedures can be offered at the hospital. 87 surgical procedures/month with 2 well-equipped theatres are in use. Expenses continue to rise.

Phil has been approached by Urologist, Andrew Fuller. There is a need for Trans Perineal Prostate Biopsy equipment. Phil has taken up the challenge of raising funds for this equipment. In this area, 90-100 men have to go to Adelaide for this procedure. The cost is \$142,000 with \$15,000 per year for maintenance. Permission has been granted for the purchase and ongoing maintenance will be covered.

A benefactor in Adelaide has offered \$80,000. Phil indicated that there will be support from his Board and the Auxiliary and he is seeking support from other Community groups.

President Ken presented a cheque from the Rotary Club of Encounter Bay for \$1,000 to Phil and an additional \$185 was raised by members on the night.
