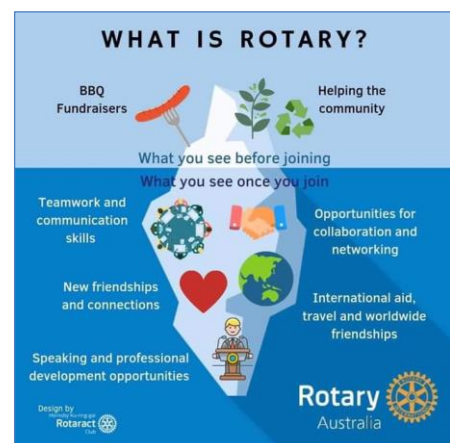

Guest Speaker – Jim Mavromatis – Guitars for Veterans

Jim shared his life story in an open and honest way. He has dealt with many obstacles that have, at times, had a devastating effect on his physical and mental health. The path to Guitars for Vets Australia has been a roller coaster ride. A positive focus for Jim has been his involvement in providing guitars, lessons and encouragement for veterans struggling with their mental health. More than 400



veterans have suicided – many while waiting for assistance from DVA. Jim has written 623 songs and many have been recorded. Fund raising, sponsorship and corporate support have enabled 10 free lessons to be offered to a group of 5 vets at a time over zoom. Their motto is “where words fail, music speaks”. Jim’s aim is for a calmer life and to assist others along the way.
