As of **1 July 2022**, site fees will be expected to be prepaid. Payment can be made online or at your bank to receive confirmation of your booking and placement at the Market. Stallholders must have also registered using (Booking Sheet Attachment A).

Casual Stallholders – please pay stall fees prior to each market you are allocated to. If you have received a late site allocation – please pay ASAP.

Permanent Stallholders – please pay stall fees by COB **Wednesday**, prior to the day of the market.

If unwell e.g., COVID/unwell, a copy of the RATS test with date will be accepted & market payment will be transferred to another agreed upon market date by Mary-anne or Cherilyn.

Please note any Cancellation of Market/s by Rotary Club of Encounter Bay, site payments will be transferred to another market. Stallholders who do not have the ability to make prepayments must make an alternative arrangement with the Market Director Mary-anne or Cherilyn (Rotary Market Team).

Alexandrina Council have moved a step closer to commencement of construction works on the Goolwa Wharf Precinct Revitalisation Project.

- Goolwa Wharf Markets will remain within Jaralde Park.

- BBQ area will be relocated
- New BBQ area will include table and chairs
- Commencement of works will commence September/October
