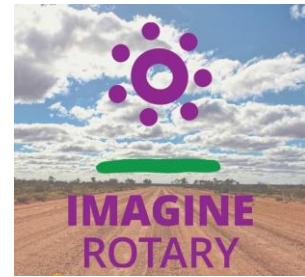

Guest Speaker Chair Brenton Abbot introduced Mark Rose who is a merchant at the Goolwa Market and who provided the Club with a detailed presentation on Bee Keeping. Mark has been a Beekeeper for 10 years. European bees came to Australia in 1822. He manages around 40 hives on the Fleurieu Peninsula with up to 50,000 bees in a hive with generally 1 queen, a few 100 drones (males) and the remainder female worker bees. They are now threatened by the varroa mite present in Newcastle.

Honey is effectively bee vomit which is highly beneficial for health and wellbeing. Bees enjoy herbs, simple flowers such as a rose of sunflower, fruit as well as native trees and agricultural crops. Honey and beeswax can be made into numerous products – all available at the market. Mark had samples on hand.

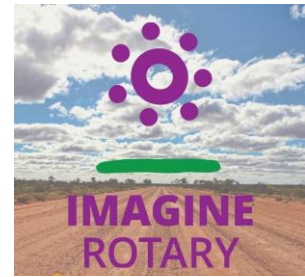
