Justin firstly was pleased to confirm that our club's previous donation had been well used for the purchase of incubators which are essential for the treatment of injured wildlife. The organisation receives no Government funding and relies on revenue from its op shops and various fundraisers and donations.

They are responsible for over 1200 rescues per year, 60% of which result in releases back into the wild. This requires a budget of \$100,000 p.a.

Justin then showed a video of various releases and was pleased to take questions from members.

The rescue centre is based in Goolwa and the organisation relies on 60-70 volunteers, 20 at the centre. Many injuries to wildlife are human related (e.g., Motor vehicle hits) and distances travelled for rescues often depends on the animal involved. The centre has particularly developed expertise in treating Pelicans, Penguins and other seabirds and the longest travels usually relate to these. The final remarks related to the possibility of hosting a vocational visit sometime in the future and this will be investigated by both sides.
