Stuart Ellis reminded members that the Fleurieu Community Foundation and RCEB invited members to the annual Quiz Night fundraising event to vie for the perpetual 'Wally Bradley Cup' on 23 June at the Encounter Bay Football Club.

Chairperson Madeleine Jenkins introduced guest speaker **Ella Jacka** Director of the Victor Harbor Community Childcare Centre with **Donna Richter**. The VH Community Childcare Centre opened in 1989 as a Not-for-Profit Centre and has operated on the hospital grounds since that time. However, the lease will expire in November 2030 and to date, no alternative site or buildings have been identified.

The Centre accepts children from 6 Weeks to 6 Years housed over three rooms, with over 70 Children attending with 28 staff supporting the centre including two Ngarrindjeri women. They ensure places remain available for children at risk and children with additional needs and complex backgrounds. There also remains a waiting list. The children conduct a wide range of activities including art, beach Kindy, NAIDOC engagement, Art Shows and the Christmas pageant. Ella is also engaged in training early childhood educators at TAFE.

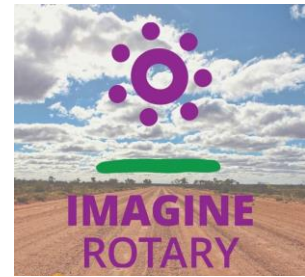

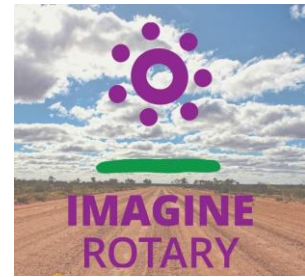
