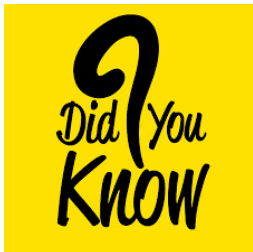

It covers 1,800,000 square kilometres and stretches from the Southern Ocean, Kangaroo Island and Adelaide in the south to beyond Alice Springs in the north, extending to the Western Australia/South Australia border in the west.

Our District Governor for 2023/24 is Craig Dowling who with his wife Kiki lives in Loxton.

There is a total of 93 Rotary clubs in the District.
