GUEST SPEAKERS – Helen Hild & Mike Dixon

Sergeant Bob called on Chairwoman Sue Morisset to introduce the Guest Speakers, Helen Hild and Mike Dixon from Dementia Directions.

Helen and Mike are the principals/owners of Dementia Directions which, as they state, "empowers you to navigate the journey of dementia with care and compassion". They took the decision to establish the service following the very difficult period Helen went through having to help and support her parents

after her father was diagnosed with Alzheimers. Her personal experience made them both very aware that there is a need in the community for support and advice for family members having to care for a loved one suffering from dementia.

Helen explained what dementia is, the various forms it can take and the warning signs. Through Dementia Directions they are able to provide advice, advocacy and support including requirements such as carer respite and residential placements.

Perhaps an uncomfortable topic for our members with some nudging the seniors classification, but Helen clearly showed her deep knowledge and understanding of Dementia, as well as her caring and compassionate approach, and we appreciated her and Mike giving up their time to explain how we can

access support if it is required.
